


## USER INSTRUCTIONS



## 1.Start:

Being a hand winding watch you should wind it up completely every time you use it (Position 1). The crown will need to be wound manually 15-20 times to develop a sufficient power reserve to ensure the accuracy of the timepiece. Take care not to over do it. As you wind it you will notice that the rotor becomes charged, stop when it becomes harder. Fully charged, the power reserve lasts approximately 42 hours after this time you will have to wind up the watch, to preserve the watch working well.

2. Setting of the time:

Pull out the crown (Position 2) and move the hands to the desire time.
